SUMMARY

Downsize locally: Best and worst suburb options in Australia

Engage in a conversation with a parent or friend over the age of 75 and you'll often find a hesitance towards the idea of apartment living. For many who have spent decades in a house with a garden, transitioning to a retirement village, villa, or townhome with a courtyard represents a more palatable form of downsizing.

Downsizing in Australia brings with it a range of practical and financial benefits, bolstered by specific government incentives. This shift to smaller, more manageable properties cuts down on maintenance, boosts lifestyle convenience through easy access to community amenities, and offers a secure 'lock-and-leave' lifestyle suited for seniors with a penchant for travel.

Financial advantages of downsizing include the liberation of equity tied up in family homes, enhancing retirement funds. This equity can augment superannuation and/or Age Pension benefits, though it's crucial to assess the impact on Age Pension entitlements due to asset tests. Moreover, downsizing can yield savings on insurance, house maintenance costs and utility expenses.

Key government incentives for senior downsizers encompass:

- The Downsizer Superannuation Contribution Program: Enables those over 55 to invest up to \$300,000 from their home's sale proceeds into their superannuation, leveraging the tax benefits of the superannuation system in Australia.
- Stamp Duty Discounts: Available in certain states and territories, these discounts can substantially lower the costs linked to acquiring a downsized residence.

These initiatives are designed to mitigate the housing shortage while catering to the ageing population's needs, positioning downsizing as a compelling choice for seniors in pursuit of a secure and enriching retirement. It's advisable for seniors to obtain independent financial advice to grasp fully the downsizing implications.

However, the pursuit of suitable downsizing options is increasingly challenging across many Australian suburbs. The recent surge in house prices has heightened the demand for villas and townhomes, especially among urban buyers with existing or anticipated families, complicating the downsizing journey with a dearth of available properties and rising buyer competition.

This report delves into the optimal and least favourable suburb areas for downsizing across the nation and by capital city, aiming to guide those looking to downsize locally.

ANALYSIS

Downsize locally: Best and worst suburb options in Australia

In our initial analysis of Australian Suburb Areas (SA2s), we created two groups to examine real estate dynamics: Group A, with a younger demographic and the lowest percentage of persons aged 75 or older, and Group B, an older population with the highest percentage of persons aged 75 or older. This division into 51 SA2s in Group A and 62 in Group B revealed key insights into how age influences housing preferences.

Group A's homes, typically with 4 bedrooms, cater to the needs of younger families, while Group B prefers 3-bedroom homes, a sign of downsizing trends among older demographics. Financially, Group A's properties are more affordable at a median list price of \$670,000, compared to Group B's \$850,000, reflecting the premium price now paid for established areas closer to urban centres.

Household income dynamics also vary, with Group A showing a higher average household weekly income level, indicative of a younger, working population. In contrast, Group B sees lower average income levels, pointing to an older retired demographic more suited to manageable living spaces like villas, likely owning an \$850,000 plus home without any debt but living with a low-income.

This study culminated in 'Downsize Locally: Best and Worst Suburb Options in Australia,' highlighting the growing demand for villas and townhomes among seniors. It emphasises the market's shift towards housing that supports ease of living for the aging population, underscoring demographic changes' impact on housing trends.

ANALYSIS

A correlation analysis conducted on over 2,400 Suburb Areas (SA2s) across Australia, yielding a 'Pearson correlation coefficient' of approximately 0.54 between the count of villas and townhouses ('Villas') and the count of persons aged 75 and over ('Over 75'), has significantly informed our understanding of the housing market in relation to the aging population. This moderate positive correlation underpins the analysis presented in "Downsize Locally: Best and Worst Suburb Options in Australia," illustrating a clear but nuanced relationship between the availability of villas and townhouses and the demographic needs of older Australians.

This correlation is indicative of a trend where suburbs with a higher number of villas and townhouses tend to cater more effectively to the housing demands of the aging demographic. These property types, often characterised by their single-level layouts, low maintenance requirements and community-centric designs, naturally align with the preferences and needs of older residents. The analysis suggests that certain suburbs are well-equipped to meet these demands, offering a good selection of villas and townhouses that provide both comfort and convenience for seniors looking to downsize.

However, the correlation also highlights disparities across different regions. While some suburbs showcase a robust selection of suitable housing options for the elderly, others lag significantly behind, offering poor choices for those seeking to downsize. This discrepancy could stem from various factors, including historical development patterns, zoning regulations and market dynamics, which collectively influence the availability and type of housing stock. In suburbs with a very poor selection of villas and townhouses, older residents may find it challenging to locate appropriate downsizing options that meet their needs, potentially leading to a mismatch between housing supply and demographic demand. Coupled with higher competition from younger buyers unable to afford freestanding houses and it is easy to understand why so many elderly homeowners are staying put in their current houses.

Understanding this correlation has guided our analysis by identifying suburbs that are aligned with the demographic housing demand of older Australians, as well as those that are not. This insight is crucial for stakeholders, including policymakers, developers, and urban planners, as it underscores the need for targeted interventions to increase the supply of suitable housing options in underserved areas. By focusing on the development of villas and townhouses in these regions, it's possible to better accommodate the preferences of the aging population, ensuring that seniors have access to housing that supports their lifestyle and mobility needs.

In conclusion, the moderate positive correlation between the availability of villas and townhouses and the presence of older residents has illuminated the importance of aligning housing supply with demographic trends. This analysis not only informs the current state of the housing market but also suggests a pathway forward for creating more inclusive, age-friendly communities across Australia.
